In making the microscopic sections of the embryos and for a series of sections of a brain, the latter of which were unstained, I am indebted to Professor T. D. Biscoe. For mounting some of these sections for study, I am indebted to Dr. C. B. Johnson of Providence, R. I., who also kindly cut, stained, and mounted preparations of the digestive canal. Within the past year I again returned to a study of the brain, using the methods of staining employed by German observers, Dietl and Krieger, also by Mr. E. T. Newton. The sections of the brain were cut and stained, as also those of the eyes, parts of the stomach and rectum, kidneys...
