It was cut short by the determination of his father to allow him no more time for these studies, and to insist on his devoting himself to the law. So he was entered at New Inn, 1494, removed to Lincolns Inn, 1496, and finally called to the Bar at the age of about 22 or 23 in 1500. In 1499 he made the acquaintance of the great scholar Erasmus, who had been brought to England by his patron, the young Lord Mountjoy. He was profoundly impressed by the learning and wit of the great humanist, who wrote a most life-like description of him to Ulrich von Hutten, 23 July, 1519, when all the scholars of the Continent were talking about the English author, whom the Utopia had recently made famous. It must have been in the autumn of 1499, when Erasmus was staying at Lord Mountjoys house at Greenwich, that More and a legal friend played a trick upon him, by...
